AFTER SCHOOL ART CLASS AT KGHS

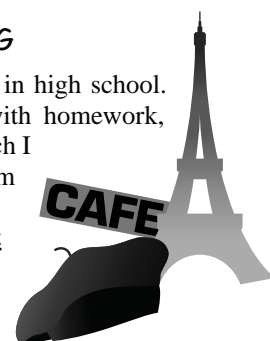

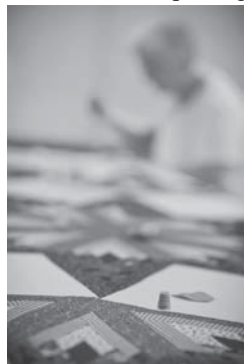

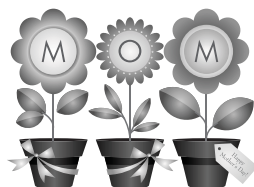

Registration for Programs

Via fax if you are at a program deadline and followed up with a payment either by sending in the mail or coming in person to the office.

Online registration is available for those interested in making a payment by credit card. Currently, this is the only method participants may use with a credit card. Please note that there is a service charge when registering online.
